Learning Mentor	2 days per week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Social and emotional support – working with pupils and supporting parents where possible.</li> <li>Child protection support.</li> </ul>
Intervention teachers	1.5 day per week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teachers who run specific interventions in reading, writing, maths and phonics.</li> </ul>
Class based Teaching Assistants	15 full time equivalent	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In-class support for individuals or small groups of children.</li> <li>Working with outside agencies to support individuals/ groups.</li> <li>Delivering targeted interventions.</li> </ul>
SEN Teaching Assistants	6 full time equivalent	<p>As class-based Teaching Assistants. SEN teaching assistants will additionally:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Facilitate enhanced adult: pupil ratios to support the implementation of EHC Plans.</li> <li>Run additional sessions such as lunchtime support and Sensory Circuits.</li> </ul>

Specific Learning Difficulties Outreach team (Lewisham)	1 day per term (from Sept 23)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Assessment and advice for pupils who are dyslexic (referral only).</li> <li>Developing practice within the school through training/ learning walks.</li> </ul>
Speech and Language Therapist (Words First Ltd)	2 days per week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Individual assessments on referral.</li> <li>Direct work with children and their teachers, support with strategies, advice and training for staff.</li> <li>Supporting the delivery of Targeted Interventions.</li> </ul>
Drumbeat School Outreach Team	2 visits per term	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Assessments, advice and strategies for children who have a diagnosis of Autistic Spectrum Disorder.</li> </ul>
Outreach Inclusion Service	½ day per week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Strategies and advice targeting those pupils whose self-esteem and behaviour affects their confidence as learners.</li> <li>Mentoring identified pupils.</li> <li>Supporting Secondary Transfer.</li> </ul>
Educational Psychologist	9 visits per year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cognitive assessments.</li> <li>Advice to staff and parents on a range of learning needs.</li> <li>Staff training.</li> </ul>
Lewisham Sensory Team	Weekly visits & Advice on request	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Access to support and advice for children with visual or hearing impairments.</li> </ul>

Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service	Referral	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Access to support and advice for children with Mental Health issues.</li> </ul>
Animal Assisted Therapy	½ day per week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Therapeutic work with individual pupils in school.</li> </ul>
Occupational therapy	Referral	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Access to support and advice for children who have difficulties with fine and gross motor skills as well as sensory needs.</li> </ul>
Training for staff – health and safety	<p>Training during school year 2022-2023 has included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First Aid, Specific Medical Needs and EpiPen Administration, Child Protection Procedures.</li> <li>• Training in specialist programmes eg Catch Up Reading (TA)</li> <li>• Emotional Literacy Support (TA)</li> <li>• Strategies to support ASD in Early Years (EYFS staff)</li> <li>• Autism Champion (TA)</li> <li>• SAL programmes (TA)</li> <li>• Sensory Needs (all staff)</li> <li>• Relational Approach to Behaviour Management (all staff)</li> <li>• Playground Support – Introduction to the OPAL programme (all staff)</li> <li>• Unlocking Letters and Sounds Programme (all staff)</li> </ul>
